The Transit Operators are responsible for transporting passengers according to prescribed schedules, ensuring passengers submit the correct fare, issuing and accepting transfers, and assisting passengers with route information, destination, location and terminal calls. The incumbent may also operate the Handi-Transit Bus, providing service to physically disabled persons including assistance to and from Transit vehicles.

This opportunity is for a temporary part-time position – must be available at short notice for any shift (including days, evenings and weekends) with a guarantee of 20 hours per week. Transit Operators advance to permanent through seniority.
